

**NAME**

CURLINFO\_EFFECTIVE\_URL – get the last used URL

**SYNOPSIS**

```
#include <curl/curl.h>
```

```
CURLcode curl_easy_getinfo(CURL *handle, CURLINFO_EFFECTIVE_URL, char **urlp);
```

**DESCRIPTION**

Pass in a pointer to a char pointer and get the last used effective URL.

In cases when you've asked libcurl to follow redirects, it may very well not be the same value you set with *CURLOPT\_URL(3)*.

The **urlp** pointer will be NULL or pointing to private memory you MUST NOT free - it gets freed when you call *curl\_easy\_cleanup(3)* on the corresponding CURL handle.
